Cycle facility campaigning

- Meetings with Camden Council, regular ones with Dave Stewart and WRSAG and others as the need arises, e.g. on Camley Street, Hampstead Heath and segregation
- Regents Park: Stefano has continued to attend meetings. Broadwalk cycling on horizon.
- Hampstead Heath. Replied to consultation. Lobbying, support from Sustrans.
- Kings Cross cycling - draft report from Philip Loy
- Cycle parking - discussions with Highgate New Town
- CRISPs (cycle route implementation and stakeholder plan)
 - final reports on links 27 and 28 - work started; mini CRIM in Chalk Farm Road
- Consultations only about 20 since May, all on web and the majority had input from members
- LB Camden have Greenway funding for Camley-Agar link and Spaniards Road shared use path
- Bike Bus with Hampstead Parochial - CCC awarded new grant to train parents
