## **Consultation on one way Camden Mews**

I am writing on behalf of Camden Cycling Campaign, the local borough group of London Cycling Campaign (LCC). We have over 600 members and represent the interests of cyclists living or working in the borough of Camden. We have consulted our members by email on this issue and this response reflects the views of the membership.

We are fully supportive of the proposal to address the issue of rat running along Camden Mews between Camden park Road and York Way and are in favour of reversing the direction so that Camden Mews is one way from York Way towards Camden Park Road.

However, the scheme as proposed will also penalise cyclists wanting to take this route, unreasonably sending them round by a longer route. We therefore propose that you should apply a "Cyclists exemption" to the "No Entry" at the junction of Camden Mews and Camden Park Road. Camden Mews is a very quiet road, so all that is needed is a simple exemption for cyclists at the entry and a complementary 960.2 sign instead of the "ONE WAY" sign at the York Way end.
