We the undersigned are regular users of the long-established and previously well-constructed Somers Town cycle route that links the southern end of the Royal College Street cycle tracks to Euston Road and Bloomsbury.

Use of the route is severely hampered by the very unsatisfactory traffic management arrangements put in place for the Edith Neville reconstruction project. The changes in Purchase Street, Polygon Road and Charrington Street are totally inconsistent with Camden's stated policy to prioritise and enable active travel. There appear to be solutions, but the Council seems unwilling to consider them, although this important route has been interrupted since December 2017 and the interruption will we understand persist until at least April 2019.

We write to bring this to your attention and ask you to initiate action to remedy the currently very unsatisfactory situation as quickly as possible.
