9.45 for 10.00 departure from Sidings Community Centre, West Hampstead NW6 2BA

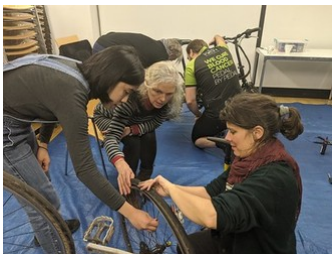
or 10.30 start at the German Gymnasium, King's Cross N1C 4BU
