4. Update on Low Traffic Neighbourhoods in Camden –

- Implementation of timing and advanced warning was poor.
- Arlington LTN is very good despite this
- Where there is no physical barrier they need enforcement.
- The ANPR camera in Mornington Street is due next week
- They need to stop Google suggesting illicit routes.
- Camden no longer have a mobile ANPR Camera e.g. for enforcing the filter on Jamestown Road
- We know of no others that are imminent.
- Swiss Cottage Cllrs are keen to get an LTN in South Hampstead.

 - Haverstock Hill - petition against cycle lanes at full council meeting

Euston Road Cycle Lane removal

Cycleway 6 Signals

- Signals at Midland Road/Euston Road and Royal College Street/Crowndale Road junctions are frequently not giving cycle a green phase
- Action: John to look into the conditions for this and feedback, others to report specific instances.
