Infrastructure Gains in Camden in 2020

Thanks to the new Covid-19 Streetspace funding and the simplification of consultation, 2020 has seen an amazing leap in provision for cycling. [See our report](#). New pop-up cycle lanes, together with work already started on Prince of Wales Road, have resulted in a trebling of the provision of protected cycle lanes in Camden.

New cycle contraflows were introduced in a dozen streets; and half a dozen other barriers were opened up for cycling.

The first Low Traffic Neighbourhood was created in the Arlington Road area; and 10 other road closures produced a few mini-LTNs. In addition, a dozen school streets have opened.

Meanwhile, Camden continue with their bikehangar program - 70 new ones were installed in 2020.

Haverstock Hill - needs your support

Conservative councillors have started yet another campaign against the proposed cycle lanes on Haverstock Hill and are supporting a crowd-funded legal challenge.
