CAMDEN SQUARE AND C50 SCHEME CONSULTATION

Camden Square Area Safe and Healthy Streets and C50 cycle route

The filters for the Camden Square area low-traffic neighbourhood (LTN) were completed as a trial in December 2021 and the C50 cycle route completed in Summer 2022.

In addition to making the scheme permanent, this consultation proposes many enhancements including the following:

- a new design to replace the diagonal filter on Murray Street at Camden Square east
- on C50 replace the wand-protected lanes with stepped tracks
- a parallel crossing over Agar Grove between Murray Street and the Agar-Camley link

The response deadline is Sunday, 2nd April.

PHOENIX ROAD CONSULTATION

Greening Phoenix Road Safe and Healthy Streets Consultation

Camden Council proposes to introduce new planting at two locations on Phoenix Road as well as introducing new filters including a [ban on through-motor-traffic](#) on Ossulston Street (north) at the junction with Phoenix Road. The existing no entry from Euston Road into Ossulston Street (exiting traffic must turn left) will remain.

These proposals will reduce the motor traffic on the Somerstown cycle route on Ossulston Street.
