## Kemble Street Road Safety & Public Realm Proposal

This response to the consultation on the above proposal is from Camden Cycling Campaign, the local borough group of London Cycling Campaign. We represent the interests of cyclists living or working in or travelling through Camden and aim to expand the opportunities for all to cycle safely in the borough.

We support this scheme which should bring safety and public realm improvements to all, especially pedestrians and cyclists, by slowing traffic at the junctions and making it easier for people to cross the roads. This will be especially important when Space House reopens.

We also support the proposals to modify the waiting and loading restrictions and to relocate or remove parking bays where needed.

As part of the scheme we would like to see more cycle parking, possibly in combination with the greening, or on Kemble Street either opposite the build-out or past the junction with Kean Street where the footway widens. At present there are a couple of lamp-post hoops but nothing else. Sheffield stands would be best but if not, additional lamp-post hoops would be very useful especially with the proximity of the City Lit.
