Response to Consultation on Keeley Street

This response to the consultation on the above proposal from Camden Council is from Camden Cycling Campaign, the local borough group of the London Cycling Campaign. We represent the interests of cyclists living or working in or travelling through Camden and aim to expand the opportunities for all to cycle safely in the borough.

We think this is an excellent scheme in every way and note the support expressed in 2021 from the redevelopers of Space House and London Living Streets as well as local councillors. It builds on Camden's commitments to reduce the dominance of motor vehicles and would be a great improvement to the area. The proposed design looks good and the excellent visualisation shows how the layout should naturally reduce the likelihood of pedestrian/cycle conflict. We fully support the closure of Keeley Street to motor traffic.

We also support the changes to motor vehicle parking, the introduction of a dockless hire bay, and the proposed informal pedestrian crossing of Wild Street.
