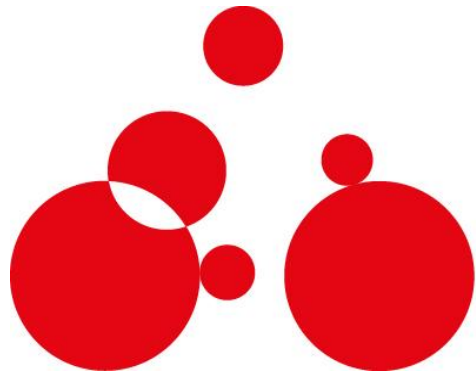

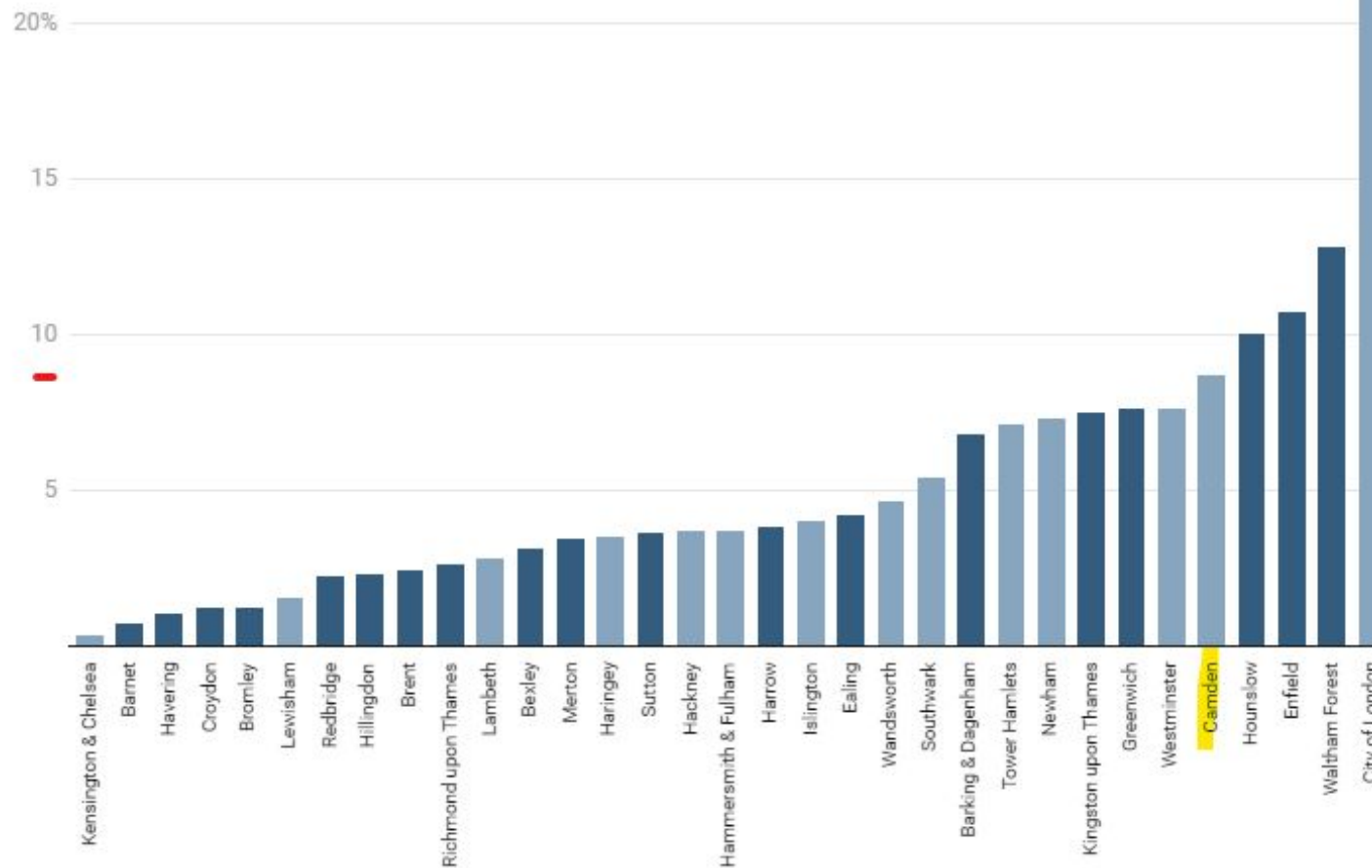

# Healthy Streets Scorecard 2023

Camden is a high-performing inner London borough on the Scorecard year after year, but it notably delivers beyond its expected score when adjusted for density compared to other inner London boroughs.

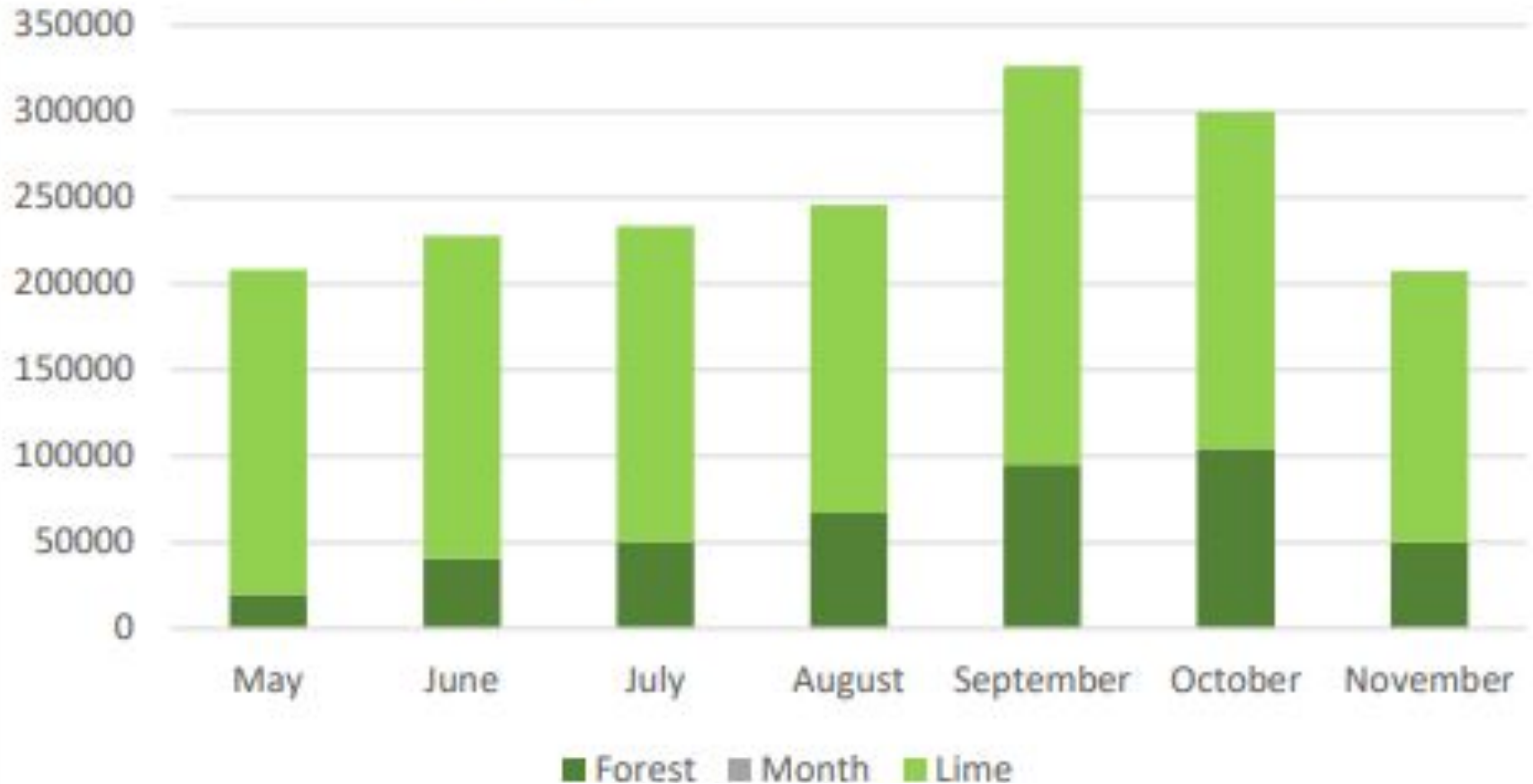

# Hire Bike Usage in Camden

Camden now records approximately 200,000 Lime rides per month (May '24 data)

## Numbers of rides per month 2023



Figures do not include trips that start outside of the borough and end in Camden or trips that ride through Camden without stopping meaning that the total number of rides in the borough is likely much higher than this.

Camden aims to have a total of around 280 dockless bays by 2025.

More than a million cycle journeys are made in London every day, and almost half of us already cycle or want to start, so Londoners are cycling more and more.

# LCC's ask for the Mayor's 3rd term

## Safe cycling for everyone

Cycling has to feel safer for more Londoners to do it. This means bringing forward 'Vision Zero' targets to 2030 and getting serious on tackling needless deaths and serious injuries on our roads with funding and resources for collision investigation and junction improvements.

## Cycle routes for all

Complete the cycle network so everywhere in London is connected. This means finishing the 'Strategic Cycling Network' ahead of schedule, by 2028, so 70% of Londoners live within 400 metres of a high-quality route.

## Funding for everyone

A level of active travel funding sufficient to spread cycling across London's diverse communities. This means ringfencing TfL's active travel budget at 2022/23 levels as a minimum until 2028

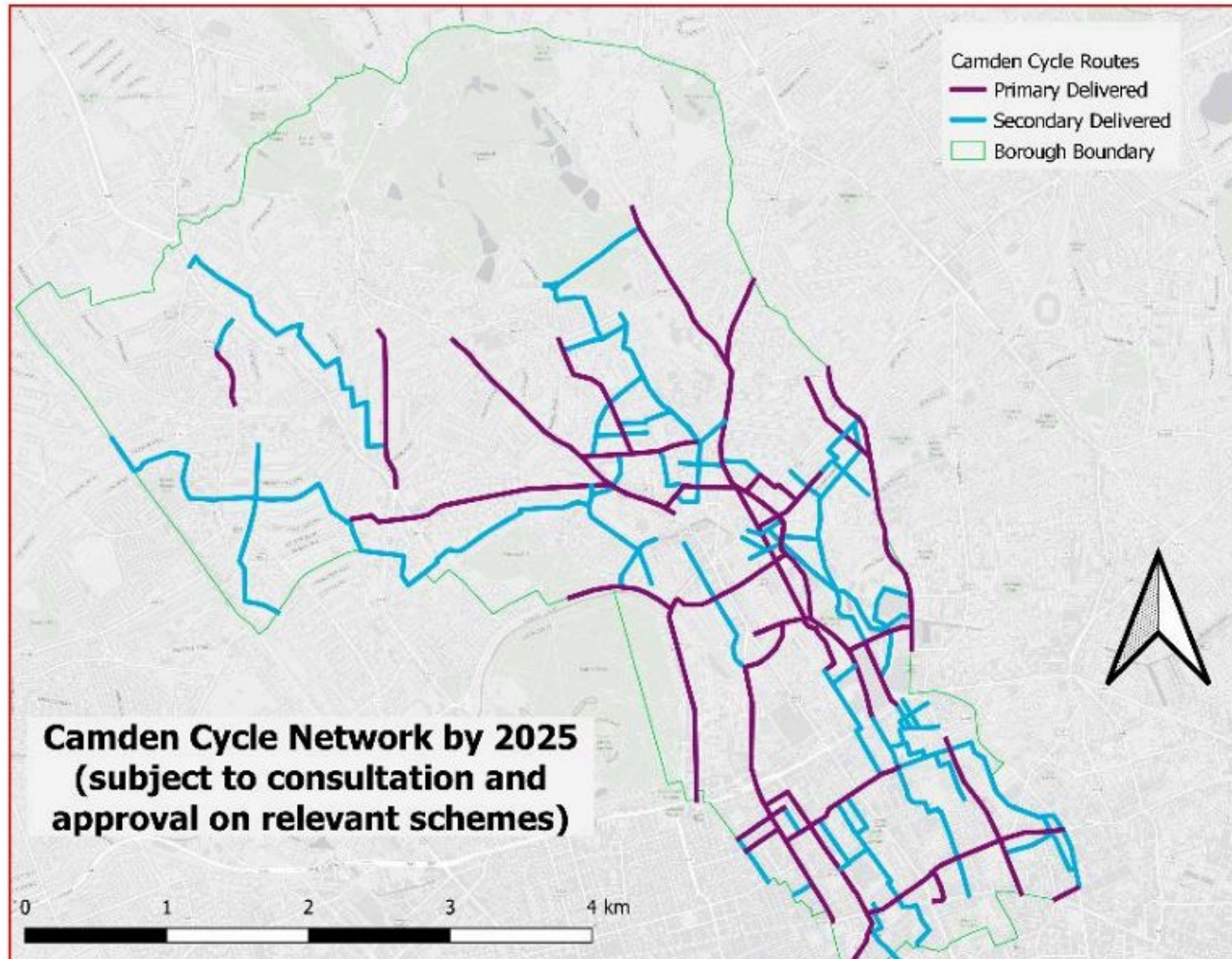

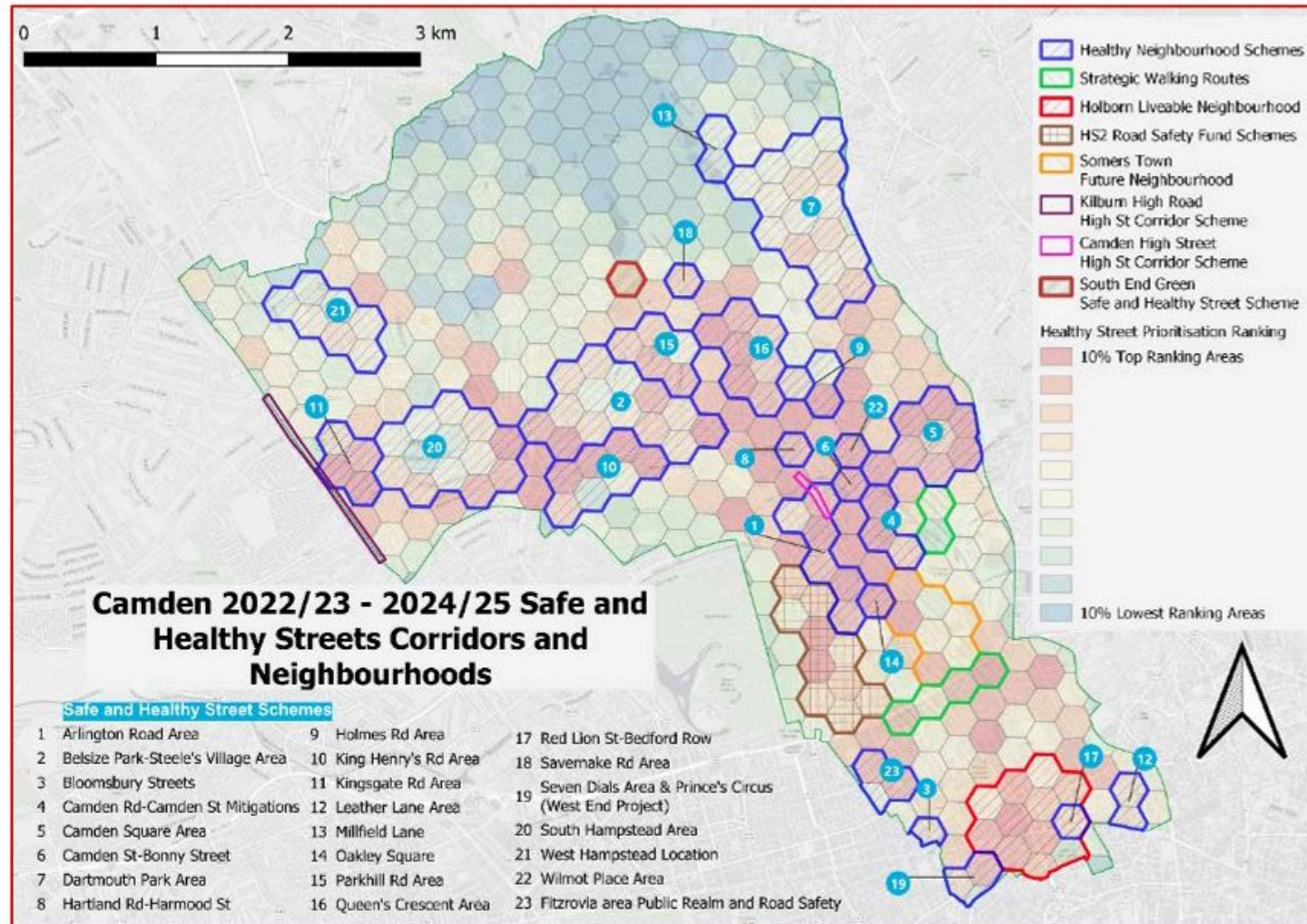
# Camden's Cycle Network (to 24/25)

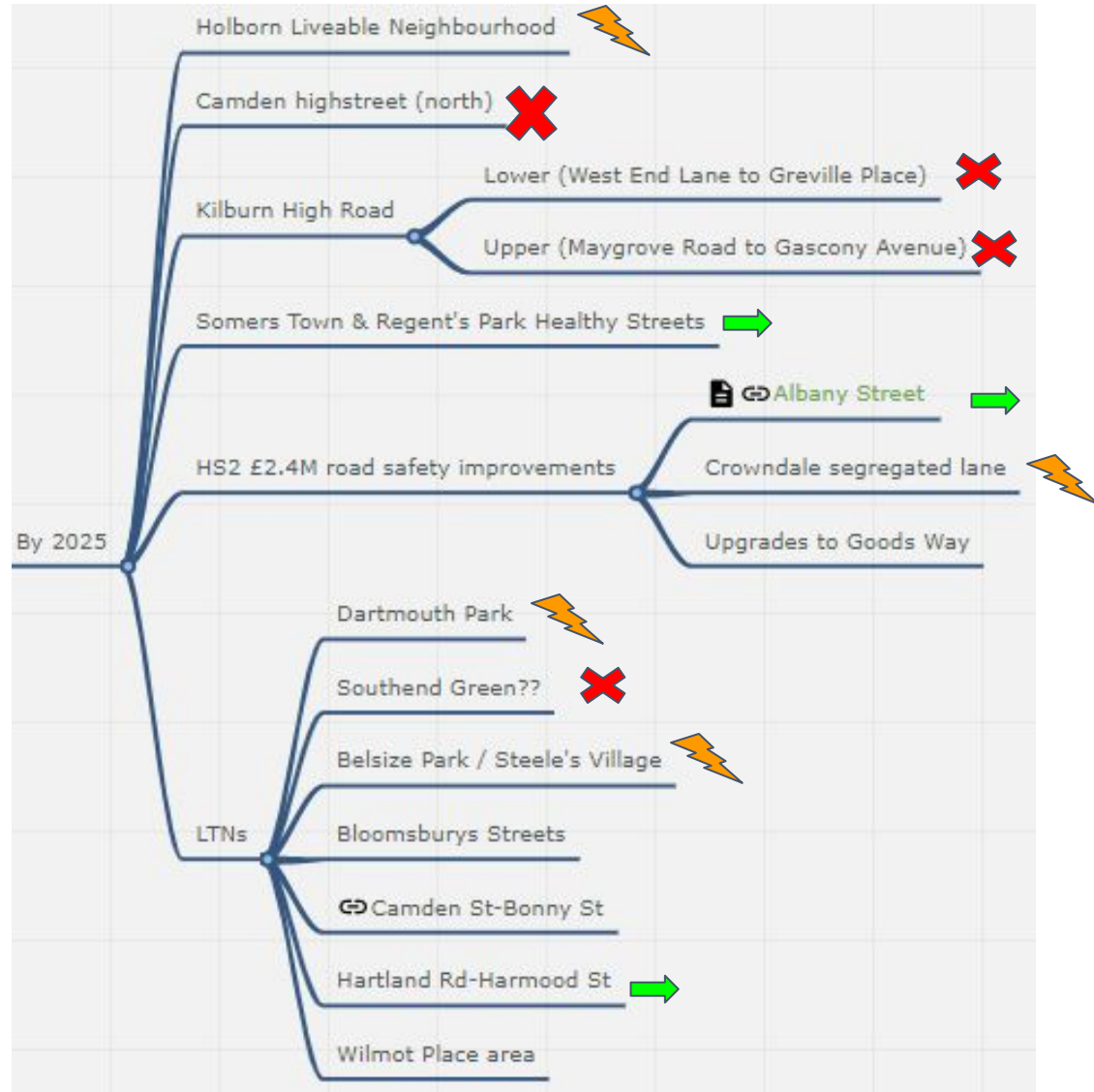
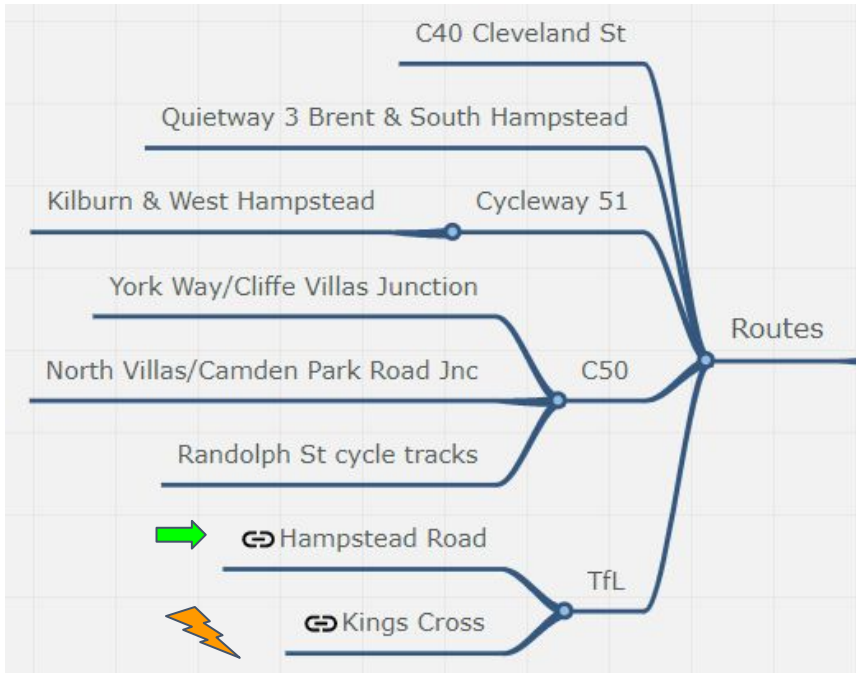
Figure 4.3 Safe and Healthy Street "corridor and neighbourhood" schemes 2022-2025

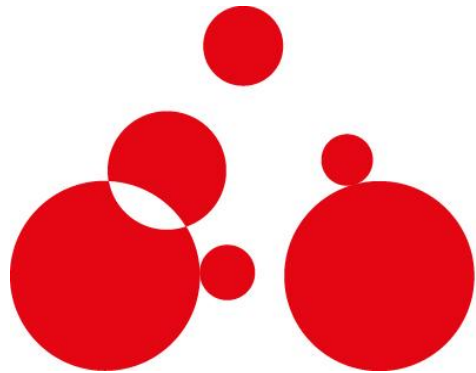

# Infrastructure Progress since May 2023 - 1



## ***Flexi bollards out - stepped tracks or kerbs in***

- PoW Road, Oakley Sq to Hampstead Road : 
- York Way: ~ 1/3; Tavistock Place: ~ 2/3
- Chalk Farm Road: started

## ***New extensions to cycle network due soon***

- Procter Street (200 m): due in August
- Crowndale Road (2 x 300m): start expected late summer
- Clerkenwell Road (2 x 450m): consultation Mar  
*all to be stepped tracks*

# Infrastructure Progress since May 2023 - 2

## Junctions and crossings

- Proctor Street/High Holborn well under way
- Tavistock Place upgrades at 3 junctions
- Blended junctions with Dutch kerbs on York Way, CfR and PoW
- Toucan and Tiger crossings connect routes across main roads.
