CHESTER ROAD SAFE AND HEALTHY STREETS

We're proposing changes to improve the streets around Chester Road. We want to make it easier, safer, and more accessible for people walking, wheeling and using buses to travel in the area.

Our proposals include:

- Adding a disabled parking bay on Dartmouth Park Hill next to the side of Chester Road Hostel making the area more accessible.
- Adding a bus friendly continuous pavement on Chester Road at the junction with Dartmouth Park Hill. This is where the pavement continues over the road giving people priority over vehicles.
- Updating the dropped kerbs around the Chester Road Hostel to help with refuse and recycling collections. This will include taking out ones that are no longer needed and adding in one new one.
- Adding places for people to wait in the road to help people crossing at the junctions with Bramshill Gardens and Bertram Street.
- Removing a dedicated disabled parking bay outside 37 Chester Road that is no longer needed.
- Adding double yellow lines at junctions and some areas in between to improve road safety and to make travel by bus and refuse and recycling collections easier and safer.
- To make these changes we would have to make changes to parking including removing a total of 7 resident permit holders parking spaces. 5 resident permit holder parking spaces next to 41-47 Chester Road would be removed.

We will make a decision on whether to go ahead with the proposals based on evidence including the consultation responses, policies, Officer observations, and other data.

It won't be possible to reply to your comments individually but all responses will be considered. Once the consultation closes we will look at all the responses and make changes to the proposals if needed. We will then write a report with recommendations for the Director of Environment and Sustainability who will make the final decision.

If approved, we will write to you again to update you on the decision.
